

Basic Certificate

The Basic Certificate in Women's Studies is designed for individuals **who are not already enrolled at SDSU**. It offers an opportunity for adults to increase their understanding of women and gender in society and culture, and learn about the ways that women and others have lived, worked, thought, resisted, created knowledge, and engaged in cultural activism. The Certificate is offered through the SDSU Open University, which is part of the SDSU World Campus. Register for course and pay fees [through World Campus](#) (sdsu.ces.edu). In Fall 2022, [Open University fees](#) are \$300 per unit for undergraduate courses.

Core Curriculum

The basic requirement for a certificate is any **FOUR** Women's Studies courses at the 300- or 500-level (total of 12 units). These can be taken at whatever pace, in whatever order, and what works best for you. Courses can be in-person or online, or a combination of both.
